OVERVIEW

Collections Support volunteers will help the Museum Collections Coordinator and Curator/Supervisor document museum artifacts. Volunteers will gain behind the scenes access to the museum collection handling artifacts, assisting with digitization, and performing research as needed.

COMMITMENT

- Make a minimum commitment of 1 year
- Be available for a minimum of 3 shifts per month

TRAINING

- Attend museum orientation
- Review of Volunteer Handbook for policies and procedures
- Attend safe handling of artifacts training

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist with data entry
- Assist with the organization of collection while ensuring safe handling of museum artifacts
- Assist with research
- Assist with the scanning of collection items and relevant documentation
- Assist staff to photograph collections items
- Edit images as required - ei. colour correction, resizing, etc.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Interpersonal and communication skills
- Ability to work independently and in a team setting
- Excellent attention to detail
- Ability to follow detailed instructions

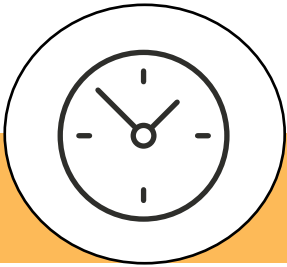
